

State Line Heritage Days Parade Entry Form/Application

Applications are available for completing at the following Union City businesses: Aukerman's, Jo's Corner Florist, State Farm Insurance, Jim's Auto Detailing and First Merchants Bank. Interested parties are encouraged to stop by any of these locations to fill out and turn in the form. If unable to make it to one of these locations, interested parties should contact Jim Dubeansky, Parade Chairman, to apply over the phone. Applications can also be completed via email.

**Securing your place and registering early is highly recommended. Entries are entered in the order they are received. Those registering the day of the parade will simply be added on to the end of our historical parade. Those who wish to pre-register have until July 29, 2020 to do so. The day of the parade, registration for all entries will be at North Side Elementary School under the awning. The address is 907 North Plum Street. **

Our parade welcomes all. We encourage churches, farmers, car owners, fire equipment, law enforcement, semi-trucks, enthusiasts, civil organizations, school sports teams, school clubs and marching bands to join us. All entries are given a participation ribbon, and qualifying entries will earn a plaque for placing based on the judge's decision. Plaques will be awarded for: school spirit, best of show fire equipment, best of show law enforcement equipment, most creative, largest farm equipment, largest truck display, best display for club & organization, and largest commercial display. Chairman's choice will be best of show overall and that entry will receive a trophy.

This year's parade will be changing route. The beginning of the parade will be at the corner of Walnut and Division streets heading south, continuing left onto Oak street, right onto Columbia street, left on Pearl street and following down to A&W on the Ohio side. It is recommended for those that are walking to have a ride at the end of the parade.

Please be careful with candy and handouts. We ask that you hand items out instead of throwing.
